DESCRIPTION: GL1800 Trunk Lid Organizer **FITMENT:** Honda GoldWing GL1800

PART NUMBERS: 3516-0125 (for 2001-2010) and 3516-0132 (for 2012-2017)

OVERVIEW:

- Trim, functional organizer fits snugly to the inner wall of your GL1800s trunk.
- Organize your trip packing and maximize your cargo space using the organizers storage pockets.
- A variety of elastic bands keep your flashlight, tire gauge and other gear in place, but easily accessible.
- Easily installs to the trunk with the included quick release snap strip and self-adhesive hook-and-loop fastener tape strips.
- Installation can be completed in minutes with no modification to your motorcycle.
- Removes in seconds so you can use the convenient carrying handle to take your belongings in the hotel or your home at the rides end.
- Rugged construction will last a lifetime with its 600-denier and 150-denier polyester materials.

IMPORTANT:

A WARNING:

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE INSTALLATION!

Because of the variety of motorcycle configurations, other accessories, and the features and intended use of this Saddlemen accessory, there could be many different mounting options. You are responsible for the proper installation of this luggage onto your motorcycle. Your attention to these installation instructions and recommendations will permit safe and proper use of this luggage. You must mount this bag properly and securely before riding your motorcycle. If you lack the ability to safely and properly install this bag, seek out a qualified motorcycle technician for assistance. During installation, support the motorcycle with a suitable stand or lift so it will not tip over and injure you, or damage the vehicle. Using or mounting this bag improperly could result in a loss of control of the motorcycle which could result in damage to your motorcycle or other personal property, the property of third parties, and/or personal injury to yourself or others, up to and including death.

A WARNING:

BE SURE TO THOROUGHLY READ AND CLOSELY FOLLOW THE MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS THAT ARE INCLUDED WITH THIS ACCESSORY:

- The organizer must be installed and securely placed within the trunk of your vehicle.
- For your safety, mount the accessory securely so it will not shift or move while riding. Make sure the accessory will not contact the controls or any other moving parts of your vehicle.
- Thoroughly inspect your organizer before each ride. Do not use your organizer if the mounting system has been modified, or has deteriorated, loosened or is beginning to fail.
- Do not exceed two pounds of total cargo weight, including the weight of the organizer, in the organizer.
- When using this or any accessory, do not exceed your trunk's Maximum Cargo Load Capacity, or your vehicle's Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight as listed on your vehicle or in the manufacturer's owner's manual.
- Carefully secure and protect items placed in, or adjacent to, the organizer (use special care to protect eye wear, shields or helmets).
- Do not transport or store flammable or potentially explosive materials in your organizer.
- Continually check the security of the organizer at each stop as you ride. Mounting hardware or straps on a motor vehicle can loosen during operation, so be sure to check these items frequently.
- If your organizer is ever damaged, do not use it until it has been inspected by a professional motorcycle dealer. Replace the organizer immediately if it has damage that will prevent it from being properly secured to your vehicle or if it is unable to securely hold its contents.
- If you do not understand the Mounting Instructions or this warning label DO NOT mount this organizer and remove any related items you may have installed on your vehicle. Contact your local professional motorcycle dealer for assistance, or call the Saddlemen support line at (310) 638-1222.

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO USE THIS LUGGAGE IF:

- You do not understand these installation and use instructions;
- You do not understand any part of the accessory mounting system;
- You have any doubts as to the security of the mounting system.

If you have any concerns or questions, seek help at a qualified motorcycle dealer or call the Saddlemen support line at (310) 638-1222. To avoid injury, install while engine is cold.


INSTALLATION:

- 1. Open your bike's trunk. Thoroughly clean the inner surface of the trunk lid before mounting the organizer. Use a cleaner that will not leave residue or damage the surface of the inner lid.
- 2. Your trunk will have interior panel mounting screws located around the perimeter of the lid. These will also be used as mounting points for the six vinyl Snap Brackets included with this kit. Using the chart (A) as a guide, undo two or three screws at a time, fit the appropriately shaped vinyl snap bracket, and reinstall the screws. Install the snap brackets one at a time until all six brackets are in place. NOTE: Some bikes may require trimming of the vinyl snap brackets. If required, use a heavy duty shears to carefully trim the vinyl so the mounting holes line up.
- 3. Make a preliminary fit of the Lid Organizer onto the snap brackets. Adjust brackets if necessary.
- 4. There are strips of "loop" fastener material across the back of the organizer. Premounted to these strips are corresponding "hook" tape strips with adhesive backs. This hook & loop material is used to add additional mounting security when used with the mounting tabs attached to the lid's interior hardware.

To install the organizer with the hook & loop material strips, remove the protective tape from the back of the "hook" strips.

NOTE: If you are using the hook & loop fastener strips in addition to the mounting snap tabs, make sure the organizer is snapped in place before pressing down firmly on the adhesive hoon & loop backing.

NOTE: In about 24-hours, the fastener strip adhesive will be at full strength and you can remove the organizer from the inner lid by separating the hook and loop material.







CAUTION:

- Failure to install any of these accessories properly may allow portions of a bag or its mounting straps to come into contact with the motorcycle's moving parts or controls. It is vital that you verify that neither this accessory, nor any of its parts touch, or interfere with, other motorcycle components while the steering and suspension moves through its entire range of motion.
- It is your responsibility to make sure the installation of this accessory does not create an unsafe or illegal condition. Check to be sure that all lights and safety reflectors are visible once your accessory bag is in place. If the bag blocks any side reflectors, place reflectors on the exterior sides of the bags (reflectors with self-adhesive backing are available from motorcycle or automobile supply stores).

Remember: Motorcycling can be a dangerous activity. Installation of any accessory can increase your risk if it is not installed properly. You are responsible to install this accessory so it will not contact any portion of the drive train, suspension or steering, or if it will in any way interfere with the operation of your motorcycle.

After 50 miles (80 kilometers), recheck the security of all mounting hardware. Inspect periodically during normal maintenance checks thereafter. Inspect the bag and related hardware before, and during, each ride. A loose bag or hardware can interfere with the vehicle's operation and cause an unsafe riding condition.
